

Prof. Michel Burnier

Dr. Michel Burnier, MD, is Emeritus Professor of Nephrology and Hypertension at the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Lausanne, Switzerland and former Head of the Division of Nephrology and Hypertension at the University Hospital of Lausanne. He has been trained in Internal Medicine and Nephrology in Lausanne, Switzerland and at the University of Colorado Health Science Centre, Denver, Colorado. He is a member of several Swiss and international societies in the field of nephrology and hypertension. He was a member of the Scientific Council of the European Society of Hypertension as treasurer and member of the Committee of the Swiss Society of Hypertension. He is the past president of the Swiss Society of Nephrology and of the Swiss Society of Hypertension. Pr M. Burnier participates in the Editorial Board of several international in the field of Hypertension and Nephrology. He is author of more than 700 publications.

His research interests are the renal mechanisms of hypertension and the pathogenesis of disease progression in chronic kidney diseases with a special emphasis on the role of sodium. He has also worked on the clinical pharmacology of new antihypertensive drugs in humans with a special emphasis on drugs affecting the renin-angiotensin system and on drug adherence.
